

Children's ICF/IID Single Point of Entry and Level of Care Review Cumulative and 4th Quarterly Report FY20

Census

The Family Resource Consultant (FRC) continues to work closely with the Director of Social Work at St. Mary's and the Social Worker at Holiday House to maintain accurate information regarding the census. In the past timely communication regarding admissions presented a challenge to maintaining accurate census information, however since the implementation of Single Point of Entry, the FRC has been better able to track admissions and ask for status updates for pending applications.

As of the beginning of the fourth quarter for FY20 (April 1, 2020), the census at St. Mary's was **83** and there were **28** children residing at Holiday House (**111**). During the fourth quarter of FY20 (April 1, 2020 – June 30, 2020), there were 0 admissions and 0 discharge at Holiday House leaving the census at **28**. St. Mary's had **5** admissions and **1** discharge bringing the census to 86. There were no deaths this quarter. The total census as of June 30, 2020 was **114**.

Table 2: Census Graph



Single Point of Entry and VIDES Summary

During the 1st quarter of FY20, the Community Transition Team (CTT) completed 20 VIDES; 8 children and 12 for adults.

Of the **20** VIDES completed:

- 20 individuals were referred to the Regional Support Team for review and recommendations for more integrated options.
- 3 children were admitted to ICF's.
- During the 2nd quarter of FY20, the Community Transition Team (CTT) completed 5 VIDES; 4 children and 1 for an adult.

Of the **5** VIDES completed:

- Five individuals were referred to the Regional Support Team for review and recommendations for more integrated options.
- Five children were admitted to ICF's (1 from a previous quarter).
- One adult is currently pending admission (currently in hospital).
- Three individuals received Face to Face contact to discuss more integrated options.
- One individual received phone contact to discuss options that are more integrated.
- Four individuals received the Community Transition Guide.
- Two CSB awareness letters were mailed to the CSB with the VIDES results.
- Zero Community Transition Guides were mailed to ICF residents. Six-month mailing is due by the end of January 2020.
- Eight of the SPE individuals have completed their initial LOC reviews.
- Fourteen individuals are awaiting their initial LOC reviews.
- Two children under the age of ten were discharged from St. Mary's Home.

During the 3rd quarter of FY20, the Community Transition Team (CTT) completed 16 VIDES; 5 children and 9 adults. 2 (1 adult & 1 child) of the 16 VIDES were completed by the CSB.

Of the **16** VIDES completed:

- Two individuals received Face to Face contact to discuss more integrated options.
- Four individuals received phone contact to discuss options that are more integrated.
- Six individuals in the SPE process received the Community Transition Guide. (Indicator 10)

- One hundred and ten Community Transition Guides were mailed to ICF residents during January 2020. (Indicator 10)
- Thirteen of the SPE individuals have completed their initial LOC reviews. (Indicator 9)
- Twelve of the SPE individuals are awaiting their initial LOC reviews. (Indicator 9)
- There were no children under the age of ten discharged this quarter. One individual is in active discharge at St. Mary's Home. Efforts have been halted in response to CoVid 19. (Indicator 12)
- Fifty-one annual contacts were completed with families in order to develop a family outreach plan. Forty-five messages were left with families. Seven families require translation services to participate in the annual contact. Nine families had contact numbers that were out of service. (Indicator 13)
- Six Admission Awareness Letters and four Active Discharge Letters were provided to the Community Services Boards. (Indicator 15)
- Sixteen individuals were referred to the Regional Support Team for review and recommendations for more integrated options.
- Ten adults are pending admission (adult admissions are not tracked).
- During the 4th quarter of FY20, the Community Transition Team (CTT) completed 1 VIDES; 1 child and 0 adults.

Of the 1 VIDES completed:

- One family received phone contact to discuss more integrated options. The Community Transition Guide was mailed. (Indicator 7)
- One hundred and thirteen Community Transition Guides were mailed to the families of ICF residents during June 2020 (Indicator 10)
- Thirteen of the SPE individuals have completed their initial LOC reviews. (Indicator 9)
- Seventeen of the SPE individuals are awaiting their initial LOC reviews. (Indicator 9)
- There were no children ten or under discharged this quarter. St. Mary's Home has two children in active discharge status. (Indicator 12)
- Ten annual contacts were completed with families to develop a family outreach plan. Seven messages were left for families. (Indicator 13)
- One Admission Awareness Letter and five Active Discharge Letters were provided to Community Services Boards. (Indicator 15)
- Thirty-four families were linked to the VCU Family to Family Network of Virginia between 5/7/2020-6/25/2020. An update on 32 of the referrals was received on 7/2/2020. Of the 32 referrals processed, sixteen families provided no response, five families indicated they were not interested, seven families were linked to a mentor, and four families remain undecided. (Indicator 13)
- > There have been 5 diversions since May 1, 2018:
 - Age 15- parent decided to take the individual home. Children's Hospital of King's Daughter assisted with securing needed equipment so that the individual could rehab at home
 - Age 7- parent decided to keep the individual at home. Case management services were added
 - Age 18- Individual received a CL slot in Dec 2018

- Age 18- Placed in foster care services with Barry Robinson. Individual transitioned home with services at age 18
- Age 14- decided to maintain CL waiver slot, exploring sponsored residential services
- > There were no reports of unavailable services during the 2nd quarter.
- > There were no reports of unavailable services during 3rd quarter.
- > There were no reports of unavailable services during 4th quarter.

Level of Care Reviews

During the fourth quarter of FY20 (April 1, 2020 – June 30, 2020), the Community Transition Team (CTT) conducted a total of **0** Level of Care (LOC) Reviews. All reviews were suspended in March 2020 due to Covid-19. This included **22** reviews for St. Mary's Home and **7** reviews for Holiday House. During the 4th quarter, the CTT received responses to LOC recommendations for October 2019-December 2019.

This allows the CTT to provide feedback regarding areas of non-compliance from the previous year so that appropriate steps can be taken to address them as the ISP is being developed for the coming plan year.

Demographics

The majority of the beneficiaries residing at both St. Mary's Home for Children (44%) and Holiday House (50%) are between the ages of 11 and 17 years.

At St. Mary's Home for Children, there is a relatively even distribution of each gender; with males representing 43% of the beneficiaries and females representing 56%. Conversely, Holiday House is 25% female and 75% male.

There is a relatively even distribution of children residing at St. Mary's with a length of stay of 7 months to 5 years (39%); and more than 5 years (47%). This is also true for children residing at Holiday House; 46% have a length of stay between 7 months and 5 years and 46% have a length of stay of more than 5 years.

Definitions:

Admission- admission occurs when the requesting facility completes their screening and review process and the individual moves into the facility.

Diversion- diversion occurs when the Substitute Decision Maker (SDM) and /or Legal Guardian (LG) agrees to explore and consequently selects more integrative options in the community.

Denial- denial occurs when the requesting facility completes the screening/review process and it is determined that the facility is unable to adequately meet the individual's needs.

Pending- pending status occurs when the SDM or LG declines to explore more integrated options and the facility is completing the screening/review process.
